RAQBALL is a new team racket sport governed by the INTERNATIONAL RAQBALL FEDERATION (I.R.B.F.). It was created by Frenchman Chris Oven. An absolute innovation in sport, a game involving dexterity and strategy, **RAQBALL** is both fun and multifaceted, and can be practised by players of all ages and skill levels.

RULES OF THE GAME

Two teams of six players each (three in play and three replacements), each player with a racket, play against each other to win the match. Their aim: to hit the opponent's target board with the ball. The players achieve this by passing the ball between team-mates and by moving individually. The court is 20 m in length and 10 m in width. The duration of a match is 20 minutes, played in 4 periods of 5 minutes each. In an informal setting, the duration of play may be set freely.

RAQBALL is a mixed sport. As it is non-contact, both male and female players can play it together despite differences in physical strength.

RAQBALL helps exercising the child's basic skills: **COORDINATION - CONCENTRATION - SPATIAL ORIENTATION**

- 24 rackets (strung with carbon and glass fibre-reinforced nylon)
- 24 balls (matt rubber)
- 24 one-size bibs (elastane and polyester)
- 8 court marking corners (flexible PVC)
- 1 kit of court marking strips (cordura + inox)
- 2 canvas sheets with the rules of the game
- 2 sleeves with technical and coaching instructions


